The philosophy of Restorative Practice views relationships and people as the most important aspect of schools and communities. Schools that embrace this philosophy prioritise building positive relationships, creating supportive learning environments and establishing fair, democratic systems across their community. When incidents of harm or disruption occur a restorative approach seeks to address the harm caused to people and relationships and repair that harm with those most affected, rather than focusing on which rule was broken and the corresponding punishment required.

Schools adopting the restorative philosophy to build community and address conflict and harm view the approach as a platform for culture change. During this one day workshop participants will have the opportunity to explore the philosophy of restorative practice and how it is applied in classrooms and school communities.

This training will cover:

- Using circles to build classroom communities
- The philosophy of Restorative Practice and its application in schools
- Using restorative conversations to repair harm in a range of situations (1 on 1, small/large group)

Suitable for: This one-day introductory workshop has been designed for **graduate teachers, those new to a school (teachers/leaders/administrators) following a restorative philosophy or those looking to refresh previous training skills.**
